Sealed tender are invited for the supply of Veterinary Allopathy Medicine from **LICENSED VETERINARY ALLOPATHY MEDICINES MANUFACTURES only THOSE HOLDING GOOD MANUFACTURING PRACTICE CERTIFICATE, GOOD MARKET STANDING AND NON CONVICTION CERTIFICATE FOR THREE YEARS** by the Deputy Director Veterinary Services, Mahasamund District Mahasamund.

1. The tender must be submitted in sealed cover envelope and should reach the office of the undersigned on or before **16JUNE 2011 up to 3.00 PM**. The committee will open the tender on **16JUNE 2011 at 04:00 PM**. The tender can submitted personally or by registered post A.D. The envelope shall bear the address of the tenderer and shall be super scribed with the words "**TENDER FOR SUPPLY OF VETERINARY ALLOPATHY MEDICINES**".
2. The prices should be quoted inclusive of all taxes packing forwarding insurance and freight charge F.O.R. Mahasamund. The time and limit for execution of such order shall be 60 days from the date of issue of Purchase order. The tender must be accompanied with earnest money/ security deposit of **3%of the items rate quoted** in the form of: -

If the rates quoted by the firm in tender documents i.e. proposed rates & M. R. P. rates, got any difference on product information slip at the time of supply then the same must be informed to Deputy Director Veterinary Services, Mahasamund District Mahasamund. well in time (before supply). Regarding above term it is clarified that :-

- (a) After approval of Tender rate, if M. R. P. increases, there will be no change in approved rates and tenderer have to supply the order on approved tender rates how ever.
- (b) If M. R. P. decreases from approved tender rate than the rates will also decreased in same proportionate and the decreased rate will be treated as approved rate, Tenderer have to supply the medicines otherwise Deputy Director Veterinary Services has the right to take legal action.

Again if Deputy Director Veterinary Services came to know that there is a difference in the rate mentioned in tender documents and in supply goods. Then Deputy Director have to right to take appropriate action & difference amount will be de-clutch from security deposit. Tenderer are directed to in form the Authorized agent through which the Medicine will be supplied.

16. Each page of the Tender and its enclosures should be signed at the bottom by the tenderer.

18. In case of spurious preparation the rates should be quoted inclusive of excise duties.
19. The undersigned of the department bears no liability for arranging import permits for the goods ordered by us.
20. All dues regarding taxes including sales tax, Octroi duties etc. levied on the supply shall be payable by the contractor himself. The department shall grant certificate for total quantity of supply made but shall not entertain any claim on this account.
21. 3. Market standing certificate issued by the Licensing Authority.
4. Manufacturing units should have minimum turnover of annual Rs. Two crores during last financial year.
5. Good manufacturing Practices certificate.
6. Valid sales Tax clearance certificates issued by concerned Authorities.

TERMS & CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1. The tenderer whose contract may be accepted (herein after called the contractor) shall within fifteen days of receipt of information of the acceptance of the tender by him, should deposit **Rs. 10,000/-** or sum equal to 3% of the value of order placed with him, whichever is higher, either in cash or in any of the Government Treasury or furnish approved Government securities for this amount duly endorsed to the Deputy Director Veterinary Services Mahasamund, Dist. Mahasamund Raipur C.G. The amount may also be deposited in any other manner accepted to the Deputy Director in terms of general orders of Government issued from time to time. All damages or to be born by the contractor otherwise sum of money payable by the contractor to the Governor of Chhattisgarh under the terms of this contract, may be deducted from the amount of security deposit after the proper completion of the contract.
2. The prices will hold good for end of **31 March 2012**. The delivery of goods by the contractor should be at office of Deputy Director Veterinary Services Mahasamund. The cost of packing, forwarding, freight and other charges for effecting delivery at the destinations shall be borne by the contractor.
3. The Deputy Director Veterinary Services Mahasamund reserves the right to increase or decrease any one or more items of supply during the contract. The contractor will be bound to comply without any claim for the compensation.
4. All dues regarding taxes and duties including sales tax commercial tax excise duty, octroi duties levied on the supply shall be payable by the contractor himself. The Department shall grant a certificate of total quantity of supply made but not entertain any claim on this account.
5. All losses during transit due to breakage and shortage, spoilage etc. will have to be made by the contractor at his own cost.
6. The contractor shall not sublet the contract assigned to any other party or parties, the whole or any portion of the contract.
7. In case commodities indented are not supplied within the time limit or loss is not made good according to the terms & conditions of this contract, the tenderer shall be liable to pay liquidated damages and by the way of penalty the sum of 2% of the cost of order placed, shall be deducted from bill. Further it shall be lawful for the Deputy Director Veterinary Services, Mahasamund District Mahasamund to purchase the articles indented from open market at the risk and cost of the contractor who in addition to the liquidated damages, aforesaid shall also be liable for any losses or damages caused by the said purchases to the Governor. In case, however, no supply is made even after expiry of **60 days** from the issue of order of supply before closing of financial year, the amount of security deposit shall be forfeited to the Government of Chhattisgarh and the contract shall stand terminated. However, if the Deputy Director is satisfied that the delay in supply was caused by the circumstances beyond the control of contractor, he may grant him in writing, extension of time which will not exceed **90 days** in case. In such case the Head of the Department may forgo the whole or part of the liquidated damages as the Deputy Director may deem proper except the actual extra cost incurred in making purchases from open market.
8. **THE RATES WHICH ARE QUOTED WILL REMAIN VALID UP TO 31 MARCH 2012.**
9. In the event of the supply being not accepted at the destination, it shall be responsibility of the contractor to remove the same forthwith at his own charges and cost.

10. In the event of breach of the terms & conditions of the contract by the contractor, the Deputy Director, shall forfeit the security deposit of the balance there as that may at that time be remaining, for the said breach, but without prejudice to the right of Governor of Chhattisgarh to recover further sum as damages from any sum which may become due to the contractor by the Government or otherwise however.

Market Standing Certificate issued by the Licensing Authority, as a Manufacturer with at least two years continuous manufacturing License i.e. **2010-2011 and 2011-2012** in respect of items covered by Drugs and Cosmetics act, 1940 and rules there under for each drug quoted. Annexure 2: Packaging Specifications to be ensured with deliveries

1. It should be ensured that only first use packaging material of uniform size including bottle and vial is used for making supplies.
2. All primary packing containers should be strictly conforming to the specification included .
3. The cap of bottles of preparations should not carry the name of the supplier.
4. The labels in the case of injectables should clearly indicate whether the preparations are meant for IV, IM, SC, etc. use.
5. The capsule shall have the name of the drug, in addition to the logo, to improve the traceability of the capsule.
6. Packing should be able to prevent damage or deterioration during transit.
7. No box should contain mixed products or mixed batches of the same product.
8. **All glass bottles used for Liquid Orals/ External preparations shall be USP type-III glass and not recycled or second hand bottles should be used.**
9. **All containers and closures, which come in direct contact with the drug, shall comply with specification stipulated in the Indian Pharmacopoeia or any recognized Pharmacopoeias (e.g. BP, IP, USP etc)**
10. Every box should be sealed with gum tape running along the top and lower opening.
11. Every box should carry a large outer label clearly indicating that the product is for “C.G. Govt. Supply-NOT FOR SALE”.
12. Any Change in Packaging Specifications will be done only after the Deputy Director of Veterinary Services, Mahasamund Distt. Mahasamund, Chhattisgarh permission.
